Results (or Findings) (12pt, bold)

Results of the research study should be presented to reflect the research objective and

research questions.

Discussion of Findings (12pt, bold, Capitalise Each Word)

The discussion should provide an interpretation of your findings considering what is

already known from literature.

Conclusion (12pt, bold)

Summarise the result (findings) of the study to answer the research question(s). You may add recommendations based on the implications of your findings. (Do not make recommendations in bullets or number the recommendations)

Acknowledgments (12pt, bold)


