PAPER SUBMISSION FORMAT

All papers must be submitted and presented in English and be submitted in MS Word format.

Abstracts and papers can be submitted by email to aiced@aa-rf.org.

Abstract Submission format

The abstract should provide a summary of the paper in a minimum of 150 words and a maximum of 300 words. It should include the name of the author(s), the institutional/organization affiliation(s), the email address of the corresponding author, and 3-5 keywords.

Full Paper Submission:

Word Limit: The paper should be a minimum of 3500 words and a maximum of 5,500 words in length (including references, tables, graphs, and figures).

Page size: A4 (29.7 × 21.0 cm)

Margins: 2.54 cm on all sides. Font type: Times New Roman

Line space: Single. Title: Centred, 14-point sizes, Bold

Authors' Names (First name and last name), Centred, 12-point sizes,

Authors' affiliations: Centred, 12-point sizes, italic, superscripts of different affiliations (1, 2, ...)

Main text: Times New Roman, 12-point sizes.

The paper must be according to the following sections (do not number the sections)

• Introduction/background including the problem, Purpose/objectives of the paper, and review of literature.

• Conceptual (or Theoretical) framework

• Methods/ techniques – research design, the population of the study, study sample, instruments, and data analysis techniques.

- Results/findings
- Discussion of findings,
- Conclusion and recommendations
- References (APA 7th Edition format)

EDITORIAL AND PUBLISHING POLICIES

The conference only publishes original papers. No previously published work should be submitted to the conference. Similarly, the submitted manuscript should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. All submissions will be checked for plagiarism using similarity check software. Any manuscript that is found to have more than 20 percent similarity will be rejected.

Authors may not be permitted to withdraw their submission after the manuscript has been sent out for review or after the manuscript is accepted for publication.

FORMAT OF PRESENTATIONS

All presentations will be oral. Each presentation will be allocated 20 minutes.

PAPER REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE POLICY

The abstracts will be reviewed by experts in the field to determine their suitability for presentation at the conference. Full papers will be subjected to double-blind reviews, and based on the reviewers' comments, the editorial board will decide whether to accept the paper or not. All accepted full papers will be published in the conference proceedings with ISBN.

- Academic workshops for postgraduate students, researchers, lecturers and supervisors on education research methodologies, theoretical and conceptual frameworks in social sciences, publishing in prestigious academic journals, and effective postgraduate supervision
